First Amendment Auditor

On Monday, June 23, 2025, at approximately 16:05, the listed subject below enter the lobby of the courthouse and began photographing from inside lobby. The subject made reference to the fact that he had the right to film from inside the lobby area because he was filming beyond an unrestricted area of the courthouse that was open to the public and was during business hours. That the lobby area was not a restricted area and was open to the public and there were no standing orders prohibited from taking photos or videos. The subject was made the statement that no federal judge would sign such an order prohibiting such. The subject stated that he had a constitutional right to be here and that he was a journalist. The USMS was contacted and advised of the subject presence and DUSM, [REDACTED] responded along with the Lafayette Police Dept. The subject departed the building approximately twenty minutes later without incident. SUSMS, [REDACTED] was immediately made aware of the situation. The subject also visited the Lafayette Consolidated Government Building the same day for the purpose of a first amendment audit. The subject has several videos on YouTube documenting his encounters. One of the videos is titled "Riding With The Outlaw-The True story of Matt Reardon. Biographical Information: Matthew "Matt" Reardon, W/M, DOB: 03/24/1987, 5-9", 140lbs., Blond hair, blue eyes, MS DL#801186355.

NARRATIVE

Description of Occurrence

On Monday June 23, 2025, at approximately 1600 hours Supervisory Deputy US Marshal (SDUSM) [REDACTED] received a call from Deputy United States Marshal (DUSM) [REDACTED] about an unknown individual recording video in the courthouse lobby outside the court security screening station. The individual refused to leave stating it was his 1st amendment right to film video in a public area. SDUSM [REDACTED] instructed DUSM [REDACTED] to call Lafayette PD for assistance. At 1625 hrs., SDUSM [REDACTED] encountered an individual who introduce himself to be "Don". Don stated he has no official business in the courthouse, and he had a 1st amendment right to record inside the building. After various conversations and several insults towards deputies and PD Officers, Don refused to exit the building and suggested that SDUSM [REDACTED] arrest him. SDUSM informed Don that he would not be arrested because he had not done anything that warranted an arrest. Moreover, SDUSM [REDACTED] asks Don since he was in the building and had captured video footage it would be best if he exited the building if he didn't have any official business to conduct, yet Don still refused. Later after discussing the issue with AUSA Criminal Chief [REDACTED] and AUSA [REDACTED] SDUSM [REDACTED] decided to close the building since all courts had adjourned for the day to get the individual to leave the premises. At approximately 4:48PM, SDUSM [REDACTED] instructed the CSOs to close the building to the public. Don was instructed to exit the building due to closure. While exiting Don became belligerent yelling obscenities toward LPD Officers and SDUSM [REDACTED]

Updated:

On Thursday June 26th Matthew Reardon and [REDACTED] entered the US Courthouse with their cellphones recording video of the lobby. When SDUSM [REDACTED] contacted Reardon, he stated he needed to file a complaint. SDUSM [REDACTED] asked about what? Reardon said was about SDUSM [REDACTED] to which SDUSM [REDACTED] advised Reardon to contact US Marshal Service Headquarters in Washington, DC. [REDACTED] asked Reardon if he had official business and he said he had no business, just it is his right to stand inside a public building and record video. Reardon further stated SDUSM [REDACTED] was unaware of the rules posted in the lobby. So SDUSM [REDACTED] politely placed his hand on Reardon's upper back stepping in the direction where the sign is posted so that we both could read the rules. Reardon suddenly jerked back taking an offensive posture and shouted, "don't put your hands on me mother fucker, that's assault and I will have to defend myself".

Reardon and [REDACTED] continued to create loud or unusual noises by yelling obscenities/insults and demanding to see a judge. Moreover, they continued to disrupt the lobby and refused to leave and stop recording which, impeded the performance of official duties by Government employees. In that, Court Security Officers had to focus their attention on Reardon and [REDACTED] which hindered effective security screening of people entering the building to conduct official court business. Furthermore, during the disruption two unknown individuals entered the building to which Reardon and [REDACTED] demanded their names and badge numbers telling them they were on camera. It was recently discovered those two individuals were Special Agents with the Drug and Enforcement Agency (DEA) entering the building to conduct official court business.

SDUSM [REDACTED] continued to communicate to Reardon and [REDACTED] that they can't come into the courthouse be disruptive, and record because local rules and standing court order prohibited possession & use of electronic devices in the courthouse. Finally, because of Reardon's erratic behavior and inability to reason, SDUSM [REDACTED] asked Reardon had he been drinking and Reardon responded, "I haven't had a drink in 5 years mother fucker" and that "he had been with [REDACTED] all day". SDUSM [REDACTED] also asks about him stalking a public official in Oxford, MS hoping he would take note of the legal consequences and leave the courthouse. Reardon and [REDACTED] continue to be loud and disruptive saying they got what they needed saying "it's my ass". They both exited the building yelling, cursing and hand gestured obscenities.
