RELEASE ORDER

On August 26, 2025, the defendant appeared before the Court for an Initial Appearance and Arraignment pursuant to a Complaint and subsequently filed Bill of Information dated August 26, 2025, charging the defendant with 41 C.F.R. § 102-74.390(a) and (b). The Court orders that the defendant be released from the custody of the United States Marshal's Service pending further proceedings with the following two conditions:

- 1. The defendant shall obey the standing order, effective September 6, 2022: "No cell phones or other electronic devices shall be brought into the Shaw Federal Courthouse by the public with the exception of lawyers appearing in cases before the Court, jurors, and sworn law enforcement officers."
- 2. The defendant shall not violate 41 C.F.R. § 102-74.390(a) and (b): All persons entering in or on Federal property are prohibited from loitering, exhibiting disorderly conduct or exhibit other conduct on property that:(a)Creates loud or unusual noise or a nuisance; (b) Unreasonably obstructs the usual use of entrances, foyers, lobbies, corridors, offices, elevators, stairways, or parking lots.
